STUDENT WELFARE SCHEMES

1. Educational & Financial support to the students belonging to the Weaker Sections of the Society

The students belonging to SC, ST and OBC communities are provided special academic support by holding extra classes for them. Senior and meritorious students along with the faculty are involved in providing them need-based academic support. UGC and State Govt. provide financial aid to the students belonging to SC/ST/BC/OBC/BPL and minority categories.

2. Samarth Scheme

This scheme has been introduced by the College Management for the differently abled students under which fee concessions, scholarships, free books and free stationery is provided. Govt. provides financial aid to the students belonging to SC/ST/BC/OBC/BPL and minority categories. A scholarship of Rs. 1100/- per month is given to such students studying in courses running under SFS. If a student is found guilty of indiscipline or fail to pass the University Exam, scholarship will be terminated. Only University Fee and Curriculum Fee will be charged from students studying in traditional courses..

3. Woollen sweaters to the needy students

In the beginning of the winter season, the needy students are identified and are given woollen sweaters.

4. Incentive to the meritorious students

(a) Gold Medals

(i) Smt. Kishen Dei Gold Medal for College Arts Topper

In order to encourage the students of Arts faculty, Late Sh. Babu Lal Sinhal, senior member of College Governing Body and a leading Advocate of Faridabad instituted a gold medal in the memory of his mother Late Smt. Kishen Dei in 2004. This practice has been continued by his sons Sh. Raghuvesh, Sh. Lokesh & Sh. Rajesh. The medal is given to a student every year who secures highest marks in B.A. final in the college.

(ii) Alumni Association Gold Medal for College Commerce Topper

Alumni are important stakeholders and an active alumni association ensures that they participate in developing the college by providing inputs at various levels. They send suggestions and give financial support to the needy and meritorious students. The Alumni Association gives gold medal to the topper of B.Com. final year every year w.e.f. Session 2011-12.

(iii) Sagwa Mal Mangla Gold Medal for Science Topper

Sagwa Mal Mangla Gold Medal for Science has been instituted by Mrs. Gian Gupta in the memory of her father. The Medal is sponsored by Dr. Lalita Gupta, Scientist DRDO, who has been an alumna of this college. The Gold Medal is given every year to a student, who secures highest marks in B.Sc. III in University Examination w.e.f. Session 2016-17.

(iv) Sh. P.P. Dureja Award

Sh. P.P. Dureja Award has been instituted by Smt. Tara Dureja to honour her husband Late Sh. P.P. Dureja, Associate Professor in English, Aggarwal College Ballabgarh. This award is given to the student who scores maximum marks in English in University Examination in B.A. III every year w.e.f. Session 2016-17.

(v) Best Student Innovator of the year Award

Best Student Innovator of the year Award has been instituted by Romesh Chaudhary, CEO of Industrial Systems, 17/6, Mathura Road, Opposite Metro Pillar P-762, Faridabad- 121 002, who has been an alumnus of Aggarwal College Ballabgarh. This award is given to a student every year w.e.f. session 2018-19 who will come out with an Innovative Idea that could be realisedand will be decided by a Committee constituted by Principal after inviting nominations from College Students. The award consists of a GOLD MEDAL (Gold Plated Siver Medal) with a Certificate.

(vi) Means-cum-Merit Scholarship (MMS)

Sh. Pradeep K. Bansal, Chartered Accountant and an Alumnus of the College has declared financial assistance in the form of Means-cum-Merit Scholarships (MMS) to needy Girl Students studying in Aggarwal College Ballabgarh w.e.f. session 2018-19. Three scholarships, one each for girl student in each faculty (Arts, Science and Commerce in Traditional Stream) in the form of Full fee charges (100%) are awarded.
