Student Support Services

1. Free Coaching Classes for NET (UGC/CSIR) Examination

The college is running PG Courses in the subjects of Physics, Economics, Hindi, Computer Science, Mathematics, Chemistry, English and Commerce. Most of the students want to pursue career in Teaching at Higher Education institutions. Keeping this in view, the college has started free coaching classes for NET Examination for students belonging to SC/ST/BC and minority, as qualifying this test is a mandatory condition for becoming a teacher in a college or in a university. These classes are run under the aegis of UGC, New Delhi and are subject to permission in financial assistance. The classes are run after the college hours or on Sundays or holidays.

The students who register themselves for these classes are also provided relevant books and study material (subject to permission in financial assistance) Dr. Manoj Shukla is the Coordinator.

2. Free Coaching Classes for Entering into Services

There are a number of opportunities for entry into Government Services after +2 examination and Graduation. A large number of students apply for these jobs in Public Sectors. Keeping in view the demand and interest of the students, the college has started free coaching classes for preparation of various examinations conducted by Staff Selection Commission, IBPS and other Public Services.

Dr. Ram Chander is the Coordinator of these classes which are run under the aegis of UGC, New Delhi.

3. Remedial Coaching Classes

There are a number of students who do not perform well in class tests and are in need of extra coaching. The college has started Remedial Coaching Classes for the students of SC/BC/ST and Minority sections. These classes are run after the college hours. The students attending these classes are also provided study material, books and stationery. This year, the students of B.A. and B.Com. attended these classes. Dr. Naresh Kamra is the Coordinator.

4. Bridge Course and Extra Classes for Slow & Advanced Learners

At the commencement of every academic session, the students of I semester of all streams are given basic knowledge of graduation course to follow under the Bridge Course. Students are prepared for an altogether different curriculum that they are going to study in graduation under this course.

In the beginning of a session, after a fortnight, a class test is conducted for the students. On the basis of their results, slow learners and advanced learners are identified and extra classes for the same are conducted on regular basis.

5. Earn while you Learn Scheme

There are a number of meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections and are in need of financial support. The college has started a scheme entitled "Earn while you Learn" under which concerned HoDs recommend such needy students who want to work under this scheme. These students work in the college office after the classes or during their free periods. These students are given financial assistance on hourly basis.
