

Talk Show on “My Journey: From Ordinary to Extraordinary” Inspires BBA/MBA Students

The Institution’s Innovation Council (IIC) at Aggarwal College, Ballabgarh organized an inspiring Talk Show titled “My Journey: From Ordinary to Extraordinary” on 17 September 2025 in Room No. 209. The objective of the session was to motivate students to think innovatively, develop entrepreneurial mindsets, and learn from real-life experiences of successful entrepreneurs. The resource persons for the session were two dynamic young leaders—Mr. Shiwansh Aggarwal, Founder of Tranceed Technology Pvt. Ltd., and Mr. Raghav Mehta, Director of Supreme Hydraulics Pvt. Ltd., part of the Supreme-Trident Group. Shiwansh, an award-winning innovator known for creating an AI-powered business delegation platform and developing indigenous electronic speed controllers for India’s EV sector, shared how his early experiments and bold decisions shaped his passion for technology and entrepreneurship. Raghav, a civil engineering graduate from Delhi College of Engineering (now DTU), recounted his journey from working on major construction projects to rapidly expanding his family’s manufacturing enterprise from a single plant to four units that supply rubber and plastic components to leading brands such as Maruti, Hero, Royal Enfield and Havells. Both speakers candidly described their challenges, milestones, and the resilience required to turn ideas into thriving ventures, inspiring students of BBA and MBA programs to pursue their own entrepreneurial dreams with determination. Ms. Bhumika, a student of MBA 2nd year, moderated the session and steered the conversation towards understanding the differences between being self-employed and working as an employee in a firm. The speakers explained that entrepreneurship brings greater independence, decision-making power, and risk-taking opportunities, while employment offers structured growth and financial stability. She also initiated a discussion on how failures contribute to success, and both entrepreneurs shared how each setback became a stepping stone for learning and innovation.
